

**Ordinance 2011-01**  
**VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE**

**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A PETITION TO RECEIVE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 129 STEWART STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Licking County Prosecutor has filed a Motion for Order of Forfeiture of Real Property for property located at 129 Stewart Street (Parcel ID#074-342744-00.000) ; and

**WHEREAS**, Licking County has notified and offered the real property for forfeiture pursuant to section 5723.01 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village believes it to be in the best interest of the residents of the Village to accept the property; and

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio, 6 of the elected members concurring that:


Section 1: The property offered for forfeiture at 129 Stewart Street, Buckeye Lake is hereby accepted.

Section 2: That the Mayor is authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept said forfeited property.


