

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR RFQ'S FROM CIVIL ENGINEERS FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE STORM SEWER REPLACEMENT PHASE I PROJECT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.



WHEREAS, the Village Council and Mayor have determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, to secure the services of a civil engineer for a storm sewer project involving State Route 79, 6th Avenue, North Street and Highland Avenue within the village,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for RFQ's from civil engineers for the Village of Buckeye Lake Storm Sewer Replacement Project to be performed within the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.



Dear Mayor Baker,

Your request for financial assistance from the Ohio Public Works Commission has been approved for the project entitled **Storm Sewer Replacement** in the amount of **\$478,436**.

Our **Grant/Loan** agreement will be released by the Commission on July 1, 2011, assuming budget authority is in place.

You MUST NOT award a construction contract or begin construction until our agreement has been fully executed and returned to the Commission and we have received your Request to Proceed and issued you a Notice to Proceed for the project.

In anticipation of formal approval of your project you may initiate, **at your own risk**, engineering and design services. You may also advertise for bids, however you must still meet the conditions stated above.

The Project Manager named in your application, **Randy Stoll**, will receive a separate mailing on July 1, 2011 detailing other requirements of the program, including Prevailing Wage, Equal Opportunity requirements, reporting of In-Kind contributions and requesting Notices to Proceed.
