

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE 2012-03

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE LEADS COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY FOR A ONE YEAR LEASE ON THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 41 FIRST STREET FOR USE AS FOOD PANTRY OPERATIONS.

WHEREAS, a need exists for a food pantry operation in the Village of Buckeye Lake; and

WHEREAS, the LEADS agency needs more room and better accommodations to provide this service to residents of Buckeye Lake and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the LEADS agency is willing to rent this property for \$1.00 per year on a year to year basis; and

WHEREAS, the village council feels this would be an improved asset to the Village of Buckeye Lake, and the a foresaid use of this property is in the best interests of the residents of the village,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor is, and he herby is, authorized and directed to enter into a lease agreement with LEADS for the property at 41 First Street in the Village of Buckeye Lake.

Section II. That this Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period provided by law.
