

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE 2016-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE FORMULATION, IMPLEMENTATION ASSISTANCE & MAPPING FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY UTILITY USE RATE DETERMINATION, MAPPING & IMPLEMENTATION FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has ongoing repair and maintenance costs stemming from the utility companies use of our roads and right-of-way throughout the village; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code section 4939 allows for the creation of Right-of-Way use agreements to have an equal and equitable cost recovery method of passing on the cost of proper maintenance and use of our village right-of-ways; and

WHEREAS, the village desires to work with an engineer who has experience in the creation of these types of cost recovery agreements and the setup of a cost recovery systems that is equal and equitable for all utilities using our village right-of-ways; and

WHEREAS, the village must make application with the PUCO in timely manner to allow for the for the establishment of a cost recovery utility agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, that

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the proposal for professional engineering services, formulation and implementation assistance and mapping for right-of-way utility use rate determination, mapping and implementation with GGC Engineers, Inc.

Section II. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period provided by law.
