

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-02

A RESOLUTION DECLARING SUPPORT AND APPROVAL OF THE TRAFFIC SIGN RETROREFLECTIVITY MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration, (FHWA) has enacted new requirements for maintaining minimum levels of retroreflectivity for traffic signs through the National Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices effective January 2008, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (OMUTCD) 2005 Edition effective January 2010 introduced a new section (2A.09) that sets forth the traffic sign retroreflectivity requirements for Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the responsibility for the design, placement, operation, maintenance, and uniformity of traffic control devices rests with the public agency having jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, Section 4511.11 of the Ohio Revised Code dictates that the local authorities shall place and maintain traffic control devices in accordance with the OMUTCD, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is the local authority responsible for traffic control devices within the corporate limits and intends to comply with federal and state requirement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Village of Buckeye Lake hereby approves and supports the Sign Retroreflectivity Maintenance Program.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency matter necessary for the public peace, health and welfare, such emergency being the time table for compliance with new legal requirements regarding traffic signs, and therefore shall take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.


