VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION CLEAN OHIO FUND GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION GRANT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Clean Ohio Fund Green Space Conservation Grant provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public parkland and wetlands , and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is planning to make capital improvements to the village-owned 20 acre parkland and wetlands at the western edge of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2: The Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.


