VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE BUCKEYE LAKE WETLANDS PROJECT GRANT APPLICATION AND DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake Parks and Recreation Commission has prepared an OPWC Clean Ohio Fund Green Space Conservation Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor will sign and submit this funding application on behalf of the Village , and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is applying for \$75,000 of grant funding to make capital improvements to the village-owned 20 acre parkland and wetlands at the western edge of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio:


SECTION 1: The Village of Buckeye Lake herein declares its support for this application.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, such emergency being the funding application deadline is October 31, 2012 dictated by the Ohio Public Works Commission for these reasons and other reasons manifest to this council, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage by council and approved by the Mayor.
