

**VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO  
ORDINANCE 2012-19**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has received residential refuse collection services from Big O Refuse for the past five years; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has found the company to be prompt and responsive to the residents needs and willing to work with the village on additional needs as they arise; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake wishes to extend the Big O Refuse Collection contract for another five year term,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the contract attached hereto and incorporated herein is hereby APPROVED, and the Mayor is hereby, authorized and directed to execute the contract.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the fact that the current contract for trash collection services expires, and a new contract must be approved, before the end of this year, and therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
