

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2014-03**

**A RESOLUTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE TO JOIN WITH LICKING COUNTY AND OTHER MUNICIPAL ENTITIES IN THE COUNTY TO RE-ADOPT THE COUNTYWIDE ALL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (CANHMP).**

**WHEREAS**, The following local participating jurisdictions developed the Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan (CANHMP) update: Licking County, City of Heath, City of Newark, City of Pataskala, Village of Alexandria, Village of Buckeye Lake, Village of Hanover, Village of Hartford (Croton), and Village of Johnstown; and

**WHEREAS**, the mission for the Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan for Licking County, Ohio (CANHMP), is to develop a working document by researching and planning for future natural hazards, and implementing appropriate mitigation techniques that all of Licking County can utilize to save lives and protect property, reduce the cost of disasters, and provide for a rapid and efficient recovery by coordinating response efforts, as well as increase the educational awareness of natural hazard events and their effects on the people, property, and resources of all of Licking County; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Ohio Emergency Management Agency has recommended approval of the CANHMP for Licking County, Ohio be approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and has forwarded the document onto FEMA for review and final approval; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Emergency Management Agency has notified the Licking County Planning Commission staff that the Federal Emergency Management Agency has provided pending approval of the Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan (CANHMP) for Licking County, Ohio, provided the community adopts the plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, This resolution shall apply to The Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to review and update the CANHMP to strengthen community resilience on a countywide level; and

**WHEREAS**, This resolution for the CANHMP will only apply to areas of Licking County under the jurisdiction of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio. Other participating jurisdictions will need to adopt the CANHMP by a separate resolution made by that community and will only become effective for those communities upon adoption of their own resolution; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,

SECTION I: The Village of Buckeye Lake hereby adopts the 2013 update of the Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan (CANHMP) for Licking County, Ohio.

SECTION II: That this Resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
