<u>SECTION 2</u>: That the mayor be, and hereby is, directed to execute said agreement with Layton INC., pending funding.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the public health safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, and therefore, shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by council and approved by the mayor.
