RESOLUTION NUMBER 2015-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH LICKING COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE THE HEALTHY INITIATIVES GRANTS FOR 2015 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake desires to receive two healthy initiative grants for \$61,050 and \$3,650 to improve the opportunities for our residents to live a healthier lifestyle; and

WHEREAS, the Licking County Health Department desires to provide funding assistance to improve the health and well-being of the residents of our community on an ongoing basis; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.17(A) (2) requires public reading of a resolution to occur on three separate days, unless two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Agreement to receive the Healthy Initiatives Grants with the Licking County Health Department, as described in the attached contract;

SECTION 2: That in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
