We encourage organic gardening. Applications for plots will be subject to approval of the Gardener's Committee

1. I will prepare, cultivate and plant my own plot. Plots left fallow will be given to the next available applicant.
2. I agree to keep my plot, paths and surrounding areas clean, free of weeds, pests, diseases, rocks, metal and garbage. All rocks should be placed in marked buckets.
3. I agree to use only organic gardening practices ,n including mulching, companion planting, natural pest control and soil fertility without chemical fertilizers and pesticides
4. I will manage my garden with best practices in water conservation
5. I will not plant any illegal plants.
6. I understand that all guests and visitors to the garden must be accompanied by a gardener or a sustaining member , and that children under the age of 18 must be supervised by family members at all times
7. I understand that smoking, drinking alcohol or being under the influence, and/or using/selling illegal substance will not be tolerated.
8. No weapons, pets, or animals will be allowed in the garden, with the exception of seeing guide dogs or other guide animals.
9. I agree to notify the Garden Coordinators if I am unable to tend my plot for any reason. Help is available for short-term watering. Plots left unattended without notice will be given to the next available gardener on the waiting list.
10. Vehicles are not allowed on garden property.
11. I agree to harvest my crop at the end of the season and to clear the plot for fall tilling by the dated established by the Garden Coordinator.
12. I am aware of risks and hazards that may arise through participation in Buckeye Lake Community Gardens. I will assume any expenses and liabilities incurred in the event of an accident, illness or other incapacity, and hold the Village of Buckeye Lake harmless and free of any liability.
