

**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-22**

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR THE PAVEMENT OF VILLAGE STREETS ACCORDING TO SPECIFICATIONS ON FILE AT THE VILLAGE OFFICES, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT FOR SAID PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Chemcot~~z~~ Inc. of Dublin, Ohio, submitted the lowest and best bid pursuant to specifications for the paving of village streets; and

WHEREAS, the engineering firm representing the Village has recommended approval of the aforementioned bid; and

WHEREAS, the Village has applied for and is awaiting approval of a grant for financing of the project referenced herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The bid of Chemcot~~z~~ Inc. in the amount of Seven Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Three and 10/100 Dollars (\$722,643.10) for the paving of village streets pursuant to specifications on file in the Village offices is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute the contract for the aforementioned bid with Chemcot~~z~~ Inc. upon approval of the pending grant application for financing of this project.


