

ORDINANCE 2010- 36

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2010-27 AND ESTABLISHING NEW WATER RATES AND COLLECTION GUIDELINES FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That Ordinance no. 2010-27 currently reads as follows:

Section 1: That Ordinance 2008-24 is hereby REPEALED

Section 2: The Village of Buckeye Lake requires that water bills be mailed to the mailing address of the property owner and that all water fees be the responsibility of the property owner.

Section 3: The following rates shall be charged to customers of the Village of Buckeye Lake proposed Water Distribution Facilities and shall become effective when water is available for sale by the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

A. *Customers shall be billed monthly based on meter readings and/or estimated usage as follows:*

- 1. A minimum bill of \$29.00 (twenty-nine dollars) per month per EDU will be billed to each customer for water used up to 2,000 (two thousand) gallons per month per EDU.*
- 2. Additionally, a rate of \$5.25 (five dollars and twenty-five cents) per 1,000 (one thousand) gallons of water used per month will be charged for usage in excess of 2,001 (two thousand and one) gallons of water per month per EDU.*
- 3. All past due amounts must be paid and received by the water billing office by the close of business on the 10th day of the month to avoid disconnection.*
- 4. If termination of water service occurs, payment of a reconnection charge of \$50 is required prior to the restoration of water service.*

Section 4: The Village reserves the right to review and revise their rate structure as needed.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 2: That Ordinance 2010-27 is hereby AMENDED and shall read as follows:

Section 1: That Ordinances No. 2010-10 and 2010-16 are hereby REPEALED

Section 2: That customers shall be billed based on meter readings and/or estimated usage as follows:

Section 3: That customers shall be charged water tap and capacity fees as follows:

Section 4: That customers shall be charged water meter fees as follows:

Damaged Meters Repair

3/4 to 1 inch	\$50.00 plus parts
1.5 inch and up	labor & parts
(If not repairable will incur cost of new meter)	

Section 5: The Village reserves the right to review and revise their rate structure as needed.


Section 6: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, such emergency being the need to have all the fees and charges in effect for the billing cycle, and therefore, shall take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
