RESOLUTION NO. 2010-01

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE FOR ANY AND ALL ACTIONS OR STEPS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE DEMOLITION OF TWO FORFEITED PROPERTIES THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN THE H.U.D. NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake recently secured ownership through forfeiture of the property situated at 42 Sixth Avenue, Buckeye Lake, Ohio 43008, and the property situated at 138 Second Street, Buckeye Lake, Ohio 43008; and

WHEREAS, the Village has agreed to participate in the H.U.D. Neighborhood Stabilization Program as administered by the Licking County Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned program is a grant program, involving no costs to the Village of Buckeye Lake, and should result in the demolition of the two properties,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to act on behalf of the Village of Buckeye Lake to execute any and all documents, or otherwise take action necessary to undertake and conclude the demolition of two forfeited properties currently owned by the Village in participation in the Neighborhood Stabilization Program originated through H.U.D., and administered by the Licking County Planning Commission.
