A RESOLUTION TO TERMINATE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LICKING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR WATER SERVICE FOR LANDINGS AT MAPLE BAY

WHEREAS, the county Resolution No. 52, Journal Entry 377, dated November 2, 2006, enters into an agreement with Village of Buckeye Lake and Julia A Bounds Et Al, Julia L. Bounds, and Sharon B. Shell for water service to one hundred (100) new dwelling units located in the bounds Addition, parcel #7-335502-00.000; and

WHEREAS, it is determined the development on this project is moving slower than expected due to the economy, and the developer has yet to achieve substantial completion on the first housing unit; and

WHEREAS, IT IS ALSO DETERMINED THE Buckeye Lake public water system became fully operational on May 3, 2010 and is capable of serving all one hundred (100) customers in this development,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,

SECTION 1: That the Village of Buckeye Lake hereby terminates an agreement, dated November 2, 2006, with the Board of Licking County Commissioners and Julia A Bounds Et Al, Julia L. Bounds, and Sharon B. Snell for water service to one hundred (100) new dwelling units located in the Bounds Addition, parcel # 74-335502-00.000

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
