RESOLUTION NUMBER 2010-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH LICKING TOWNSHIP TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR MAPLE BAY AND HUNTS LANDING AREA RESIDENTS OF LICKING TOWNSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake is willing to provide emergency medical services to Licking Township, Licking County, Ohio pursuant to the terms and conditions of the agreement for same attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.17(A) (2) requires public reading of a resolution to occur on three separate days, unless two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,


SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached Agreement for provision of emergency medical services with Licking Township, Licking County, Ohio, as described in the attached contract;

SECTION 2: That in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
