

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2017-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RENAME HEBRON AND WALNUT ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE TO BUCKEYE LAKE BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, Section 723.04 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for the changing of street names by the legislative authority upon receipt of a petition by a person owning a lot in the immediate vicinity of the street to be renamed; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has existing houses and businesses on these roads; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake does hereby petition to have Hebron and Walnut Roads renamed to Buckeye Lake Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, council members have determined that it is in the best interest of the residents and businesses in the village to rename these roads to create a common identify for the Buckeye Lake Region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I: Hebron and Walnut Roads in the Village of Buckeye Lake will be renamed and posted as such to Buckeye Lake Boulevard throughout the Village of Buckeye Lake.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
