

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

ORDINANCE 2017-23

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A STORMWATER UTILITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN WHICH ESTABLISHES DAILY OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR THE STORMWATER UTILITY IN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake established a stormwater utility by adoption of Ordinance 2013-25 on December 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS, a stormwater utility development plan is required to establish comprehensive guidelines for the daily operation of the stormwater utility; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has completed a stormwater utility development plan dated November 27, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Village will adopt rules and regulations to properly manage and maintain the stormwater system; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio the "Stormwater Utility Development Plan" be set forth hereafter as follows:

Section I: Purpose and objective.

The Village of Buckeye Lake currently owns and operates a stormwater system for the collection and disposal of stormwater, other surface water, and for flood control. The purpose of the Stormwater Utility Development Plan is to comply with Federal, State and Local requirements.

Section II: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
