

**VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE
ORDINANCE 2018-09**

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2017-24 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake Council on January 22, 2018 passed an ordinance amending Ordinance 2017-03 establishing new water rates and collection guidelines.

WHEREAS, the adopted Ordinance was signed and presented to mayor but has not reached the 30 day wait period.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake Council wants to reevaluate the financial figures.

WHEREAS, Council finds it is in the best interest of the Village water customers to rescind adopted ordinance for the financial benefit of its customers.

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Charter requires public reading of an ordinance to occur on three separate days with at least one week between readings, unless three-fourths of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council, of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio, a Majority of the elected members concurring that:

Section 1. Buckeye Lake Village Council ordinance 2017-24 adopted on January 22, 2018 is hereby rescinded

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary to assist commerce in the Village of Buckeye Lake. Therefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
