

RESOLUTION 2018-01

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO APPLY TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Buckeye Lake is eligible to apply for Transportation Alternatives Program funding for the Buckeye Lake 2018 Curb & Walk Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Alternatives Program funding applications are due by May 18, 2018;

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.17(A) (2) requires public reading of a resolution to occur on three separate days, unless two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the legislature affirmatively vote to dispense with such requirement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE THAT FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER TO READ A RESOLUTION ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS,

SECTION 1: That the Mayor for the Village of Buckeye Lake be and herewith is authorized and directed to apply to the Ohio Department of Transportation for Transportation Alternatives Program funds.

SECTION 2: That said request shall be for improvements to connect sidewalks, improve drainage and install bicycle signage on SR 79 from Mill Dam Rd to North Bank State Park, estimated to cost approximately \$750,000.00.

SECTION 3: That in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
