

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2018-22

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AN ADVANCE, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-16 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE CONTRACT FOR THE HIGHLAND AVENUE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Buckeye Lake Village Council recognizes a need to improve the drainage in the Highland Avenue area of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the funds to complete this project were not previously available to appropriate for the project; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund has the ability to advance money to the newly created Storm Water Utility Fund to allow for this much needed stormwater drainage project; and

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Council adopted Ordinance 2018-16; and

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Council deems it necessary to amend Ordinance 2018-16.

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Council feel it's in the best interest of the Village to have the Mayor enter into a contract with ADR & Associates to complete the Highland Ave storm study.

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the General Fund shall advance \$8000.00 in funds to the Storm Water Utility Fund to provide for the ability to secure funds for the Highland Avenue Drainage Improvement Project. This amount will solely be an advance, and is not a transfer. The advance shall be repaid from the collection of the Storm Water Utility as funds become available, but not to exceed 12 months from start of collection.

SECTION II: That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Buckeye Lake during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018, the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated in addition to those in Ordinance 2018-16 as follows:

SECTION III: That the Village Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to draw their warrants on the Village Treasury for the payment of any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore approved by the same or an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make expenditures, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except for persons employed by the authority of and in accordance with the laws and ordinances of the

Village of Buckeye Lake and provided further that the appropriations can only be expended upon a majority vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village and for the purposes other than those covered by specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION IV: That the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with ADR for engineering of the Highland Avenue Drainage Improvement project.

SECTION V: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
