

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-27

AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING THE BID FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE HUNTS LANDING ROAD IMPROVEMENTS AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND SAID CONTRACTOR SUBJECT TO FUNDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has received bids for what has been termed as the Village of Buckeye Lake Storm Hunts Landing Road Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the consulting engineer has recommended that the bid be awarded to The Shelly Company: Thornville Ohio;

THEREFORE, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO THIRDS (2/3) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the bid of The Shelly Company for the Village of Buckeye Lake Storm Hunts Landing Road Improvements is hereby APPROVED, and the contract is hereby awarded to said successful bidder.

SECTION 2: That the mayor be, and hereby is, directed to execute said agreement with The Shelly Company, pending funding.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, and therefore, shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by council and approved by the mayor.
