

Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting Minutes

Correspondence: Samantha submitted a list of 12 permits approved for rental of the Recreation Center. Annetta stated draft plans for new dugouts for the ball field are being worked on. The Lakewood Girls Softball will submit their application to use the ball field for this year soon.

Unfinished Business –

Pickleball Courts: \$5,625 paid out so far and \$13,225 for work completed last year. It is an open purchase order. Might not get to the rest of the court until mid-May because there needs to be consistently good weather. She asked them to send an estimate for the fence. They recommend 6 feet all around and will do 6 foot fencing all the way around with gates. Getting backstop at the ballfield and Annetta will ask them for a fence estimate as well. Talked about possible windscreen installation after the fact. Discussion on pickleball court donators sign. Pickleball paddles on the top of the sign. Will need a sign on the pickleball court with some court rules.

Ball Field: Ball field may be used more than it was used last year because one of their fields is under construction.

Recreation Center: Robert Schilling did floor at Harbor Hills for a decent price so Annetta would like to get an estimate from him for new Recreation Center flooring. Annetta stated that Mayor Goodman had talked about having the village worker guys paint the inside of the Recreation Center but winter weather kept them very busy. Annetta got an estimate from the lady who painted the swing set. Discussion on colors for painting inside the Recreation Center. Want to get new black mats for the Recreation Center. Current ones are very old.

New Business:

Park Restrooms: Samantha will check with Tommy about water turned on at the restrooms for the season.
