The projected move on the Log Cabin is next week pending utility line moves confirmation , we will be posting on line and in the media the date and time of day of the move it will be scheduled for after School Bus runs in the mornings, businesses will be notified of the move once they reach the 4 lane northbound and southbound traffic will both be routed to that side of Hebron Rd. to allow traffic flow, it may take an extended amount of time to make the turn from Hebron Rd and Mill Dam corner, assisting with the move will be Dingey Movers, BLPD, BLFD, BL Street Department and possibly LCSO . ODOT has given us permission to issue our permit and the only thing remaining is final scheduling word from Utilities, we do have sign offs from AEP and waiting on answer from Glo fiber, and Bright Speed and Spectrum.
