Holtsberry Log Cabin status report: Cabin has been inspected for the move and for the type of foundation needed, also the Village's Engineering firm of contract is donating their fee to assist in the move, contractor is Dingey Mover's, foundation is being donated, approximately \$ 17,000 has been pledged and more coming in, utilities have been contacted as well as ODOT, we do not have a move date yet and that will be determined by ODOT getting the Village the permit. The Historical Society is also including the contents of the Cabin to be moved with the Cabin. The Cabin originally sat at Grandstaff and Mill St age of the Cabin has been discussed anywhere from late 1700's to early 1800, it will be relocated to the Village owned property on Mill Dam Rd and will become part of the over all plan that has been designed for that property to best make it afocal point of that developed area to include access to walking path on that property.
