Unfinished Business:

1. Annetta provided an overview of the current budget with proposed purchases. We as a Commission also created our "wish list" of items we would like in the near future based on this year's budget amount and what we would like to see in the future.
 - Fire extinguishers must be replaced now; as well as new locks on the bathroom doors in case they need to be opened from the outside, in case of a fire incident.
 - The following items were discussed as near future purchases for the park and/or recreation center: Seesaw (4 seater), benches (3), pickleball net, speaker podium, PA system, SMart TV with wall bracket and lighting dimmers.
 - Items for future purchase: yard games, picnic tables, replacement of skatepark equipment.
2. Future Events: Trunk or Treat, October 27th. Managed at the Recreation Center by Deb Jullian and Mayor Peterson. The Recreation Center event is a separate event from the Halloween event hosted by The Harbor.

3. Skate Park: The Commission started brainstorming fund raising ideas to focus on replacing the equipment in the skate park. Several of the current pieces are no longer safe for use. We discussed replacing sections of the skate park as fund raising permits. Some of the ideas for fund raising events are: 5K walk/run, Art in the Park event, possible grant from AEP and reaching out to some of the local businesses for donations and support.

Council Presentation: Kellie Green/Annetta Macedonia will attend the October Council meeting to give a Parks and Recreation update.

New Business:

1. The Commission wants to use the Village logo on all our documents
2. Dirt is needed around the pickleball courts, especially since the weeds were killed. There are several low spots that are dangerous for players.
3. Why don't we have signs posted that states the park and recreation center has security and cameras


