AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE VILLAGE TO POST COPIES OF ALL ORDINANCES; RESOLUTIONS, STATEMENTS, ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS, NOTICES, AND REPORTS IN FIVE OF THE MOST PUBLIC PLACES IN THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 0

WHEREAS, Section 731.25 of the Ohio Revised Code provides a procedure for publication where no newspaper is printed within the Municipal Corporation; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to publish all ordinances, resolutions, orders, proclamations, notices, and reports in five of the most public places in the Municipal Corporation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The Clerk is hereby directed to post all resolutions, statements, orders, proclamations, notices, and reports required by law to be published in the following locations which council determines to be the most public places in the Village:

1. BancOhio OFFICE
2. Post OFFICE
3. Mt. Carmel Fellowship Hall
4. GARDNER'S GROCERY STORE
5. Lakewood MARKET
6. Betty's CORNER

Section 2: The Clerk is directed to post said resolutions, ordinances, statements, orders, proclamations, notices, and reports for a period of not less than fifteen days prior to the taking effect thereof.

Section 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety and welfare.
