AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, MAKING THE PROVISION HEREOF RETROACTIVE, AND ~~DECLARING AN~~ EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the following officers should receive compensation in the amounts which follow as compensation for the performance of their official duties; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that this measure should be retroactive to January 1, 1981; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that in order for the appropriate salary to become effective for the entire period encompassed by the fiscal year of 1981, immediate action is necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED OF THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The yearly compensation to be paid as salary for the following officers is as follows:

- A. Mayor . . . . . \$1,200.00
- B. Clerk . . . . . \$1,200.00
- C. Treasurer . . . . . \$ 480.00
- D. Council Members . . . . . \$ 240.00 per member *(Start April)*

*not exceed 2 meetings \$10 per meeting-attended*  
Section 2: This ordinance shall be retroactive to January 1, 1981, and the incumbent serving in each office shall be entitled to the benefits hereof.

Section 3: For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall come into force and effect upon its passage by Council and its approval and execution by the Mayor.
