

Ordinance No. 81-17

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A STREET DEPARTMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create a Department to provide for the repair and maintenance for the streets within the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, and it is necessary to employ an individual to work in said Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: The Department of Streets is hereby created by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

Section 2: Said Department will be responsible for maintaining and repairing and constructing streets within the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

Section 3: The Mayor of the Village of Buckeye Lake is hereby granted authority by Council to hire an individual to work in said Department on a part-time basis at a salary not to exceed the minimum wage in effect at the time said employees work is performed.

Section 4: The Clerk of the Village of Buckeye Lake is hereby authorized to pay said employee for hours worked by said employee.

Section 5: Clerk is directed to pay said employee from the street fund.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
