

ORDINANCE NUMBER 82-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 434.03 SECTION C(3) OF THE TRAFFIC CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE.

WHEREAS, the speed limit on all Village streets is currently 25 mph; and

WHEREAS, the streets owned by the Village are unusually narrow and the area's densely populated; and

WHEREAS, Council is desirous of lessening the speed limit to preserve and protect life and property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: The speed limit for motor vehicles upon the public streets of Buckeye Lake, Ohio which are currently 25 mph is hereby reduced to 20 mph.

Section 2: All references in Buckeye Lake's Traffic Code Section 434.03, etc. in which the speed limit is set at 25 mph shall be amended to read 20 mph.


Section 3: This ordinance shall not effect the speed limits currently in effect on State Route 79, State Route 360 and State Route 489.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take full force and be in effect immediately upon its passage in that its passage will protect the life and property of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake by reducing the likelihood for accidents.


