AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 83-2 RELATING TO THE FLOOD HAZARD AREAS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the flood damage prevention ordinance of 1983 since the special flood hazard areas have been identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, That:

Section 1: Section 3.2 of Ordinance 83-2 entitled Basis for Establishing the Areas of Special Flood Hazard is hereby repealed and amended as follows:

3.2 Basis for Establishing the Areas of Special Flood Hazard.

The areas of special flood hazard have been identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled "Flood Insurance Study for the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio". This study, with accompanying flood boundary and flood insurance rate maps dated August 15, 1984 and any revisions thereto, is hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this ordinance. The flood insurance study is on file at the Village Hall, 5192 Walnut Road, Buckeye Lake, Ohio 43008.

Section 2: This ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
