AN ORDINANCE EXPANDING THE NUMBER OF AUXILIARY OFFICERS WITHIN THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, a need exists for additional members of the auxiliary, police department, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended the number be extended from five to ten,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The Buckeye Lake Village Auxiliary Police Unit which is hereby set at five positions by a previous Ordinance of this Council, is hereby expanded to ten positions.

Section 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to make five additional appointments subject to Council's approval.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
