AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING A LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT REGARDING THE SALARY OF CLERK/TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO.	THE

WHEREAS, when the Village purchased the municipal office complex it assumed the obligations of managing the non-governmental units in the complex; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk/Treasurer was requested, by Council, to act as property manager of these non-governmental units; and

WHEREAS, the amount of \$100.00 per month was appropriated by the Council to be increased compensation for the Village Clerk/Treasurer in assuming the duties of property manager for the non-governmental units; and

WHEREAS, a recent audit by the State Auditor's Office has disclosed the absence of any specific legislation authorizing the increased monthly salary to the Clerk/Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk/Treasurer has performed the responsibilities placed upon her as property manager since receiving the salary; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to make this ordinance retroactive to provide a basis for past compensation paid to the Clerk/Treasurer as well as future payments. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, that:

- Section 1: The monthly compensation for the property manager for the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, is set at \$100.00 per month.
- Section 2: The present property manager has received this salary since the <u>lat</u> day of <u>samulary</u>, 198<u>9</u>, without the benefit of authorizing legislation other than the annual appropriation ordinance and it is the intent of Council to make this ordinance retroactive to the aforesaid date.
- Section 3: Since the work of the property manager has been diligently performed by the Clerk/Treasurer since the <u>let</u> day of <u>lexically</u>, 19887, Council hereby forgives any claim it may have to seek repayment of the salary paid since Council had intended to pass the authorizing legislation then but, through oversight, forgot.
- Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
