AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF \$8,000.00 TO THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake recently received an amended certificate from the County Auditor indicating an additional \$8,000.00 was available for appropriation; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the usual daily operation of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: There is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the amended official certificate of estimated resources received from the Budget Commission of Licking County, Ohio, dated June , 1986, the sum of \$8,000.00 as follows:

(A) \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated to Police Salaries;

(B) \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated to Police Operation and Maintenance;

(C) \$4,000.00 is hereby appropriated to Land and Buildings.

Section 2: For the reasons set forth in the preamble hereto, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall go into full force and effect immediately.
