AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #90-06, SECTION PM-301.10 OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO, PASSED MAY 29, 1990

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance #90-06, passed May 29, 1990 in the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION ONE: Ordinance #90-06, Section PM-301.01, passed May 29, 1990 in the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, shall be amended to read as follows:

"MOTOR VEHICLES - Except as provided in other regulations and approved by the Code Administrator, junk vehicles, as permitted in section PM-301.08 and any vehicle that does not display current motor vehicle registration, shall be housed in an enclosed garage or other suitable structure as defined in Article 2, except if the person is operating a junk yard or scrap metal processing facility licensed by the authority of Ohio R.C. 4737.05 to 4737.12, inclusive, or regulated by the authority of the Village. No vehicle shall at any time be in a state of major disassembly or disrepair, unless necessary for restoration and also stored in an enclosed garage or other suitable structure."

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


