AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING DISCHARGING FIREARMS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the public health, safety or welfare to regulate the discharge of firearms within the Village of Buckeye Lake,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, TWO THIRDS MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION ONE: No person shall discharge any firearm including rifles, pistols, bows and arrows, crossbows, BB gun, pellet gun, air rifle or any othe device capable of propeling a missle that could inflict bodily injury to humans or animals or cause property damage within the corporation limits of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

SECTION TWO: Landowners who possess a minimum of 25 acres of land may use a firearm to control varmints as defined by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. Said firearm shall not use ammunition larger than .22 caliber rimfire.

SECTION THREE: Landowners possessing a minimum of 25 acres may hunt on their property in accordance with the hunting laws of the State of Ohio. Hunting will be limited to the landowner and his immediate family. Firearms used for hunting shall be limited to 12 guage shotguns using ammunition containing lead or steel shot. During the legal deer season, shotgun slugs may be used.

SECTION FOUR: Landowners will adhere to all laws set forth by the State of Ohio concerning the killing of any animal.


SECTION FIVE: No discharge of any firearms provided above shall be closer than 100 yards of any property line adjacent to any portion of the corporation limits of the Village of Buckeye Lake.


SECTION SIX: The provisions of this Ordinance do not apply when firearms are used in the discharge of official law enforcement duty or when otherwise lawfully authorized.

SECTION SEVEN: PENALTY: Any person, firm or corporation, who violates any provision of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a fourth degree misdemeanor.

SECTION EIGHT: This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


