AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PARK LAND WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE AND INSTRUCTING THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO ENDORSE SUCH VACATION TO THE COUNTY RECORDER

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio finds that a petition was filed with the Village of Buckeye Lake, and described herein; and

WHEREAS, Council further finds that there is good cause for such vacation of as petitioned for, and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; and

WHEREAS, notice and public hearing has been held pursuant to Revised Code Section 755.41,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT;

SECTION ONE: The petition for vacating the parkland described in Exhibit A attached hereto, is hereby granted.


SECTION TWO: The said parkland identified herein in the Village of Buckeye Lake, be and the same hereby is declared vacated.

SECTION THREE: That after the passage of this Ordinance, and after the effective date thereof, the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Buckeye Lake shall cause a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed in the Office of the Recorder of Licking County, Ohio and in the office of the Licking County Engineer.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


