AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #94-20, SECTION THREE OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO, PASSED DECEMBER 12, 1994 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance #94-20, Section Three, passed December 12, 1994 in the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION ONE: Ordinance #94-20, Section Three, passed December 12, 1994 in the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, shall be amended to read as follows:

"SECTION THREE: Any person, corporation or business entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense."


SECTION TWO: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake and shall become effective upon its passage of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected by the Council concurring; and if the vote of the Council is not sufficient to pass this as an emergency measure, shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
