AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING PERSONNEL FOR EMERGENCY SQUAD SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Village of Buckeye Lake passed Resolution No. 90-33, establishing its municipal fire department and authorizing emergency squad (medical unit) services as a part thereof; and


WHEREAS, such emergency squad services are immediately necessary to protect the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS (2/3) MEMBERS CONCURRING:

SECTION ONE: That one (1) additional part-time emergency squad service personnel be appointed at \$ 6.00 per hour each.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake, and is further immediately necessary to provide emergency squad (medical unit) services to citizens as part of the fire department services, and shall become effective upon its passage of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected by the Council concurring; and if the vote of the Council is not sufficient to pass this as an emergency measure, shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


