AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND GENERAL OFFENSE ORDINANCE #452.12  
OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend General Offense Ordinance #452.12 in the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING:


SECTION ONE: General Offense Ordinance #452.12 in the Village of Buckeye Lake, Licking County, Ohio, shall be amended to read as follows:


"NO PERSON SHALL STOP, STAND OR PARK ANY VEHICLE UPON THE TRAVELED PAVEMENT PORTION OF ANY STREET OTHER THAN AN ALLEY IN THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, EXCEPT THAT A DRIVER MAY STOP TEMPORALLY DURING THE ACTUAL LOADING AND UNLOADING OF PASSENGERS OR WHEN DIRECTED BY A POLICE OFFICER OR TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, NO PERSON SHALL STOP, STAND OR PARK A VEHICLE WITHIN AN ALLEY EXCEPT WHILE ACTUALLY LOADING OR UNLOADING, AND THEN ONLY FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY MINUTES."

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law and shall repeal all ordinances and /or resolutions in conflict therewith..
