AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-01 "TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE" AND  
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

An ORDINANCE to amend appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio, during the first fiscal quarter ending March 31, 2005.

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Council adopted Ordinance 2005-01; and

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Council deems it necessary to amend ordinance 2005-01 to reflect one additional appropriation item for \_\_\_\_\_.

THEREFORE,

FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Buckeye Lake during the first fiscal quarter ending March 31, 2005, the following sums be and are hereby set aside and appropriated in addition to those in Ordinance 2005-01 as follows:



SECTION 2: That the Village Clerk-Treasurer is authorized to draw her warrants on the Village Treasury for the payment of any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore approved by the same or an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make expenditures, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except for persons employed by the authority of and in accordance with the laws and ordinances of the Village of Buckeye Lake and provided further that the appropriations can only be expended upon a majority vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village and for the purposes other than those covered by specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 3: That in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake in that monies are immediately needed to meet salaries, payroll and other expenses so that the Village may continue to pay authorized expenditures this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
