

VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2005-23

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY, GENERALLY DESCRIBED
AS BEING APPROXIMATELY 8 ACRES LOCATED ON STATE ROUTE 360,
CURRENTLY IN WALNUT TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, a petition for the annexation of certain territory in Walnut Township generally described as being approximately 8 acres located on State Route 360, adjacent and contiguous to the Village of Buckeye Lake, Fairfield County, Ohio, was duly filed with the Board of Commissioners and approved for annexation to the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has forwarded the transcript of the proceedings in connection with the annexation, certifying that all requirements set forth in Chapter 709 of the Ohio Revised Code have been fulfilled, to the Clerk of Council who received the transcript on June 14, 2005; and

WHEREAS, sixty (60) days from the date of filing of said petition with Clerk of Council have elapsed, and the application may now be considered by mull Council;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The annexation of that real property as applied for in the petition of Harrison W. Smith as agent for the owner of the real estate sought to be annexed is hereby accepted. The territory is hereby described as follows:


Section 2. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to make three copies of this Ordinance to each of which there will be attached a copy of the map accompanying the Petition for Annexation, a copy of the transcript of the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto and a certificate as to the correctness thereof. The Clerk shall then forthwith deliver one copy to the State, and also file a notice of annexation with the Board of Elections within thirty (30) days after it becomes effective, and the Clerk shall do all other things required by law.

Section 3. The annexation of the above described territory of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio, shall become effective thirty (30) days after the passage of this Ordinance provided that if the ordinance is subjected to a referendum, the annexation, if approved by the Electors, shall become effective thirty (30) days after such approval. The territory annexed shall have all the rights and privileges and shall be subject to the powers of the Village of Buckeye Lake as are the inhabitants within the original limits of said municipal corporation.
