

**VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2006-01**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A  
CONTRACT WITH CAPITAL RECOVERY SYSTEMS, INC. AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Buckeye Lake ("The Village") has outstanding Mayor's Court fines that need to be collected; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council needs the service of a collection agency to help in the collection of court fines; and

**WHEREAS**, Capital Recovery Systems is a company that provides this service at no cost to the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds it is in best interest of the Village to execute this contract as soon as possible in order to help in the collection of overdue court fines and fees.


**NOW THEREFORE**, FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,


**Section 1:** Village of Buckeye Lake Village Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into contract with Capital Recovery Systems, contract is attached as Exhibit "A".

**Section 2:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the collection of court fines and fees within the Village of Buckeye Lake. Therefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
