

ORDINANCE 2006-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES IN ZONING MATTERS FOR
THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has determined it is necessary to amend fees related to Zoning matters as set forth in the attached "Exhibit A"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that such fees be put into effect immediately by declaring an emergency; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it is in the best interest of the Village to amend fees in Zoning Matters as set forth in the attached "Exhibit A".

FOLLOWING AN AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) OF THE COUNCIL TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT OF THE BUCKEYE LAKE VILLAGE CHARTER SECTION 4.04 TO READ AN ORDINANCE ON THREE SEPARATE DAYS WITH AT LEAST ONE WEEK BETWEEN READINGS,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, County of Licking, State of Ohio, a majority of the members concurring:


Section 1: The Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake hereby amends fees in Zoning matters as set forth in the attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

Section 2: In no event shall the Village be responsible to pay engineer and/or legal fees relative to the application submitted for review. All such costs shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant regardless of the fact that these services are incurred by the Village in order to properly evaluate the application. No application shall receive final determination until all such costs are paid.


Section 3: This ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake and shall become effective upon its passage of two thirds (2/3) of the members elected by the Council concurring; and if the vote of the Council is not sufficient to pass this as an emergency measure, shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
