

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-21

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY FOR THE CLERK-TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake deems it necessary that a Clerk-Treasurer be appointed to provide financial and record keeping services, to attend all meetings of Council, and, if requested, special meetings of Council; and

WHEREAS, Council also deems it necessary to fix the compensation for said position, and believed it had done so appropriately prior to this ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer, Lauralyn V. Palmer, was fixed at One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month, effective January 1, 2006, and that all prior acts regarding said salary are hereby ratified.

SECTION 2: That Council declares this to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, such a need arising out of the necessity to fix the salary for a qualified Clerk-Treasurer for the Village; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
