

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-24

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ACCEPTING AN EMERGENCY OPERATING PLAN (EOP) FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY,

WHEREAS, The Buckeye Lake Village Emergency Operation Plan (EOP) has been developed to provide to the plan holders a document that addresses missions, tasks and responsibilities of organizations and individuals for carrying out specific actions relating to preparation and response to emergencies that may occur within the Village; and

WHEREAS, This document sets forth lines of authority and organizational relationships, and shows how all actions are to be coordinated. It describes how people and property will be protected in emergencies or disasters. It also identifies personnel by title, equipment, facilities, supplies, and other resources available in Licking County for use during the response and recovery operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That this plan is approved and accepted as a statement of policy regarding emergency management and assigns tasks and responsibilities to Government officials, department heads, and private organizations, specifying their roles during an emergency or disaster situation. It is developed pursuant to Section 5502 and 3750 of the Ohio Revised Code and is effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007. This EOP replaces all Previous EOP's.

SECTION 2: That the Buckeye Lake Village Fire Department Fire Prevention Division will administer this plan.

SECTION 3: That Council declares this to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
