

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-34

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A BID FOR TRASH COLLECTION SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE OF BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO, AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR SAID SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake has advertised for and received bids for trash collections services for the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the administration has reviewed said bids, and made its recommendation; and

WHEREAS, prior bids had been rejected, upon the advice of the Solicitor, due to a potential error in the prior procedure,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the bid attached hereto and incorporated herein is hereby APPROVED, and the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute the contract related to the aforementioned bid, which is also attached hereto and incorporated herein.


SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising from the fact that the current contract for trash collection services expires, and a new contract must be approved, before the end of this year, and therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
