

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-16

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY NECESSARY FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AND AUTHORIZING THE SAME BE PURCHASED FROM ANOTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION WITHOUT BID (PER ORC. 735.053) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Buckeye Lake, Ohio wishes to purchase certain property owned by the Village of Hebron, to wit, a 2004 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN #2FAFP71W24X180211; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle, which has a value of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$2,800.00), is necessary for a municipal purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police with the concurrence of the Council deem it prudent to purchase the same, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hebron, Ohio desires to sell said vehicle, and

WHEREAS Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract, without advertising or bidding, with the Village of Hebron, Ohio for the purchase of said vehicle, such sale shall be conducted in accordance with O.R.C. §735.053.

NOW, WHEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, County of Licking, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the 2004 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN #2FAFP71W24X180211 is necessary for a municipal purpose, and

SECTION 2: That the same shall be purchased in accordance with O.R.C. §735.053, from the Village of Hebron, Ohio, for the sum of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$2,800.00), and

SECTION 3: That the Village hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract without advertising or bidding for the purchase of said vehicle and to do such other acts as are necessary to effect the purchase of said property.

SECTION 4: That in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Buckeye Lake this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and it shall become effective on its passage and signature of the Mayor.
