

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-26

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING OF A PROPOSAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF AIR PACKS FOR THE BUCKEYE LAKE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR SUCH PURCHASE, WAIVING BIDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village, through the Fire Department, has applied for and received a grant for the purchase of air packs; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has secured proposals from several companies for the sale and delivery of the air packs; and

WHEREAS, the proposal of Finley Fire Equipment is the lowest and best of those proposals,

NOW, WHEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Buckeye Lake, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the proposal of Finley Fire Equipment for Scott Air Packs being the lowest proposal received by the Fire Department, is hereby accepted, and that the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to execute any agreements necessary to conclude the purchase of said air packs.

SECTION 2: That all bidding requirements are hereby deemed waived since this is an emergency measure.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency matter, such emergency being in the best interest and the furtherance of the health, safety and welfare of the public, and arising by virtue of time tables imposed by the grant, and the necessity of securing the air packs promptly for the protection of not only the firefighters, but also the residents of Buckeye Lake, and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its passage by Counsel, and approval by the Mayor.
